## Region 14 Spring 2010 Meeting Motions

## And Discussion Points

1) <u>MOTION</u>: Moved, seconded and passed that the Region 14 Treasurer be authorized to open CD at Credit Union

2) <u>DISCUSSION</u>: Concerning producing an Electronic Bulletin.

Consensus-will proceed with Kitty doing an electronic bulletin.

Have all affiliates send Mary Lee a report

Send memorial articles to Mary Lee too, also mention of any memorial donations to the Region (not national?).

3) <u>MOTION</u>: Moved and seconded that the Region investigate renting a storage locker to store all the historical Region stuff, to be revisited at the Fall meeting. <u>Motion withdrawn</u>.

<u>Result:</u> Potential Historian Committee requested to look into the placement and cost of storage of/for Region 14 historical materials.

4) **DISCUSSION**: Concerning problems with getting judges for shows.

a. Suggestion: no signing up judges for the next year's shows until the fall regional: all societies are only allowed to sign up three judges from the fall regional until Jan 1<sup>st</sup>. After Jan 1<sup>st</sup> societies are allowed to sign up more than three judges.

b. Also suggested: Prepare a central calendar so that it's known which judges are available when and which are assigned where so that no society can get more than 3 judges before Jan 1

5) <u>DISCUSSION</u>: That keeper gifts for Regional trophies won at Spring Regional shall only be given to in-region people who show up at the fall regional.

6) <u>MOTION</u>: Moved, seconded and passed -- Notice will be sent to Regional Trophy Award winners: if the winner attends the fall regional, s/he will be presented with the keeper gift; if the winner doesn't attend. s/he will be mailed an appropriate certificate 7) <u>MOTION</u>: Moved and seconded that the Region will participate in the San Francisco Flower Show

8) <u>MOTION</u>: Moved, seconded and passed the R 14 immediately accept the offer from the Monterey Bay Iris Society to host 2012 Spring Regional

9) <u>MOTION</u>: Moved, seconded and passed to hold the Annual Budget meeting at Fall Regional preceding the regular board meeting. (Treasurer instructed to send Board members a preliminary report via email ahead of time).

10) <u>DISCUSSION</u>: Concerning digitizing hybridizers' interviews that are currently on cassette tape.

11) <u>MOTION</u>: Moved and seconded to allow Mary Lee a capped budget of \$250 to start digitizing tapes and to present a report at the Fall Regional Meeting. After discussion, the Motion was clarified and amended to apply only to the conversion of the tapes to a digital format (transcribing will be a separate thing). <u>Motion passed</u>.

12) <u>DISCUSSION</u>: Concerning the disposition of Guest Irises: how to balance revenue among hybridizers & commercial growers, affiliates, & region?

Result: A committee will be formed to come up with a possible solution for presentation to the fall meeting – committee to be composed of hybridizers, affiliates, and other interested parties.

13) <u>DISCUSSION</u>: Concerning alternatives to traditional spring regionals such as visits to botanical gardens. Visits to botanical gardens are also a possibility for fall regionals.
